

Student Responsibilities while using transportation provided by the school.

Students using free bus transportation should understand that they are under the jurisdiction of the school from the time they board the bus until they are deposited at school or the stop nearest their home. Bus service is provided to all eligible students. There is no charge to the student for this bus service. Bus drivers are responsible for the lives of all students on their buses and will not be required to transport any individual who is a disciplinary problem. If a bus fails to arrive or make a scheduled stop or if you have trouble finding the proper route, call 847-599-4787.

It is the policy of the School District to permit the use of video cameras on the school buses for the primary purpose of reducing and documenting disciplinary problems and vandalism on the buses, thereby reducing distractions to the driver, improving safety and protecting the bus property. Video tapes may be used with or without audio components. Students may be disciplined based in whole or in part on videotape evidence of misconduct. A student being disciplined based on activities recorded on the videotape, and/or the student's parent(s) may view that segment of the videotape that documents the incident for which the student is being disciplined.

In appropriate circumstances, the Superintendent is authorized to show a videotape to other government agencies, including law enforcement agencies and/or the Department of Children and Family Services.

Students violating the following rules may have their riding privileges revoked. After such action, it becomes the responsibility of the parents to transport the student.

- a. STUDENTS MUST DISPLAY THEIR I.D. CARD UPON BOARDING THE BUS FOR A TIME PERIOD AS DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION. The I.D. card will only allow a student to ride the bus to which he/she has been assigned.
- b. The bus driver is in complete charge of the bus and students are expected to comply with his/her requests at all times
- c. Students are permitted to converse quietly with persons sitting near them.
- d. All students must be seated and are not permitted to disturb other riders or to change seats when the bus is in motion.
