
How to get a pairing code?

Ask your student to get the code and share the code with you.


Student needs to log into Canvas;

2 - Click on the Settings link




Click on **Pair with Observer** button and copy the six-digit code. Share the code with the observer.
The pairing code will expire after 7 days or its first use.




Click the **OK** button

Click on [Observing](#)




Add the Student(s) - Type the **Pairing Code** and Click the **+Student button**
