This letter includes key points and information on our return to school planning for the 2020-21 school year.

At its July 21 meeting, the Board of Education approved a return to school with **our fully remote learning plan, at least through Friday, October 2.**

### Fall Athletics

At its August 5 meeting, the Board of Education approved the coordination of the 2020-21 fall sport seasons for boys' and girls' golf, girls' tennis, boys' and girls' cross country, and girls' swimming and diving, as outlined in the IHSA Return to Activities guidance. Detailed information and directions will be provided by our Athletic Department and coaches for these six sports.

### Textbook and Supply Pick-Up Next Week - Makeup Dates

To facilitate remote learning, students were scheduled to receive the necessary materials and textbooks for the first semester during the first week of August. For students who were NOT able to attend during their designated time slot, there will be another opportunity. Be sure to bring a bag or backpack to hold your textbooks and supplies. When students arrive at school, they should be symptom free, wear a mask, and practice safe social distancing.
